

Site Visit

Shatin to Central Link SCL 1108 – Kai Tak Station and Associated Tunnels

Date and Time: 16 September 2017 (Saturday) 9:00 am to 11:30 am

Project Introduction

The Shatin to Central Link (SCL) is a strategic railway line that stretches from Tai Wai to Admiralty, connecting several existing railway lines and passing through multiple districts in Hong Kong. It will serve the areas in East Kowloon where are currently not covered by any railway services with newly built stations, and helps to strengthen the linkage between the New Territories and Hong Kong Island.

The Kai Tak Station is located at the former Kai Tak Airport. The Scope of Works of SCL Contract 1108 includes the construction of the Kai Tak Station and the approx. 720m long associated tunnels towards To Kwa Wan Station. The tunnels were primarily constructed by cut and cover method, with a small section constructed by mining method to preserve the Former Kowloon City Pier.



Site Visit Itinerary

The participants would be furnished with a presentation of project brief followed by a site walk introducing the construction status and actual site works for the Kai Tak MTR Station. The arrangement of site walk might vary subject to the site condition on the day of visit.
