

Site Visit

Central Kowloon Route – Kai Tak West

26 January 2019 (Saturday) 9:00am to 11:30am

The Project

Central Kowloon Route (CKR) is a proposed dual 3-lane trunk road across central Kowloon linking the West Kowloon in the west and the proposed KTD in the east. It will connect the West Kowloon Highway at Yau Ma Tei Interchange with the road network at Kowloon Bay and the future Trunk Road T2 at KTD in order to fulfill the need for additional traffic capacity on the east-west road links across central Kowloon, particularly for coping with the new developments on its western and eastern sides.

Kai Tak West (KTW) is one of the eight contracts of CKR. The main works include construction of an approximately 370m underwater tunnel and the associated temporary reclamation in Kowloon Bay, an approximately 100m cut and cover tunnel and an access shaft in Ma Tau Kok as well as an approximately 60m cut and cover tunnel, 130m depressed road and 200m underpass in the Kai Tak Development.
